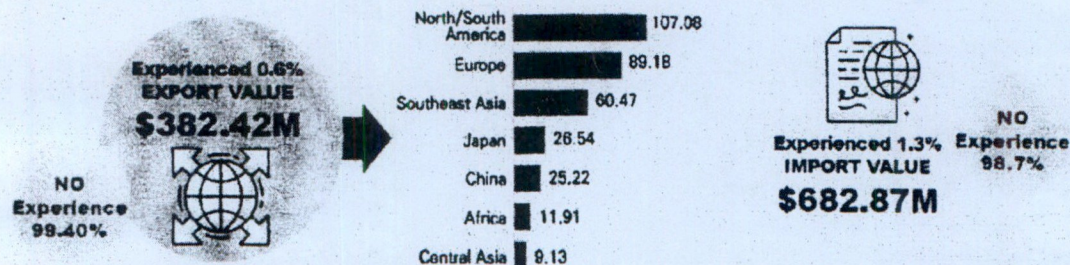


Export-Import Experience and Scale in Korea Disaster Safety Industry

•Overseas Export Experience / Value

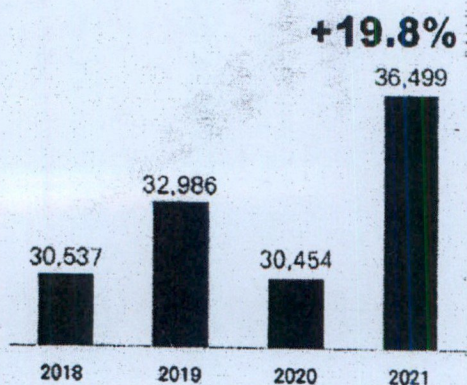
•Export Value by Region(USD million)

Trends in the Revenue of the Domestic Disaster Safety Industry (USD Billion)

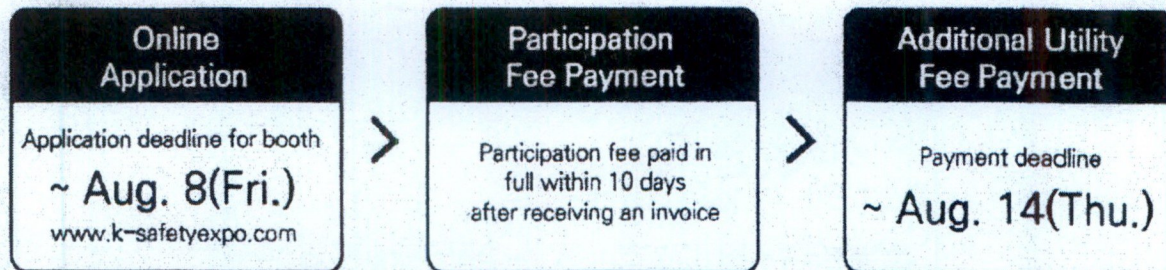


As a country entering the ranks of advanced nations, South Korea has been continuously strengthening safety regulations. In January 2020, the Industrial Safety and Health Act was completely revised and strengthened, and in January 2021, the Serious Accident Punishment Act was announced. Since January 2024, this law has also been applied to workplaces with fewer than 50 regular employees, which has driven significant growth in the disaster safety industry.




The South Korean government has defined the disaster safety industry as the sector that develops, produces, and distributes technologies and equipment or provides services related to protecting citizens from disasters and various accidents.

Furthermore, to ensure the safety of its citizens through the introduction of advanced technologies, the South Korean government has been actively promoting the disaster safety industry. This effort began in January 2023 with the implementation of the Disaster Safety Promotion Act, led by the Ministry of the Interior and Safety. In 2024, the government introduced a Basic Plan for the Promotion of Disaster Safety, aiming to systematically foster the disaster safety industry through policy initiatives.
